Blockstand questionnaire: What is it?



Goals:

- Gauge the level of awareness and involvement of SMEs with blockchain technology.
- Gather feedback from relevant stakeholder groups involved with blockchain technology and related standardisation activity.
- Based on the result of the questionnaire and follow-up interviews, build a mapping of needs, existing barriers and recommendations for future blockchain standardisation work.
- Provide crucial data for the Blockstand Gaps and Recommendations Atlas, one of the central deliverables of the Blockstand project

Blockstand questionnaire: Structure



- The questionnaire is structured in several sections:
 - General information/Demographics
 - Blockchain adoption, involvement and experience (with specific questions targeted at each of the different target groups)
 - Awareness and involvement in blockchain standardisation
 - Needs and recommendations for blockchain standardisation
- At the end of the questionnaire, respondent are asked for their consent to participate in follow-up interviews based on their input

 - Trust Anchors Management
 - Verifiable Credentials for eSignature
 - European Digital Identity / EU Digital Identity Wallet
 - Conformity with eIDAS Regulation / eIDA+S 2 electronic ledger trust service
 - Qualified Seals, Signatures and/or time-stamps based on DLT
 - Smart contracts
 - Other
